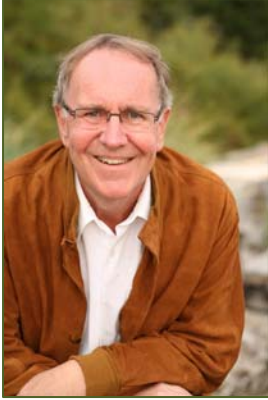


## **Michael Lewis**
